CITES REGULAMENTATION:

During last CITES conference, on the 4th October 2016, some woods are added on the protected list species. For the following woods will be necessary some other certification, and they will take some weeks of delay due to CITES office verification.

Rosewood will be not available as customisation at Overload guitars and It will be replaced with Pau Ferro.

The protected woods are : Indian Rosewood – Honduras Rosewood – Cocobolo (Dalbergia Retusa) - Bubinga.

We will still use Bubinga for the next years, using the right export documents, until we finish it. After that, we will use other same wounding wood in exchange like Purpleheart and Padouk.

TRAVELLING INFO

If you are travelling with your Overload guitar, with some exotic wood on it, don't worry, cites rules are not so restricting for traveler musician.

The limit is fixed at 10 kg for each instrument (case excluded), and each guitar is obviously less than 10 kg. But if you'll travel with more than 2 instruments, you should ask for proper document to travel with them. For any info, feel free to write us at our mail - info@overloadguitars.com
